

Man charged after auto-bicycle crash

A man has been charged with automobile homicide following the death of a bicyclist who was run down and later died from his injuries on Oct. 16.

Rogelio Molina is charged with the third-degree felony, as well as a class A misdemeanor for failing to give his name and assistance at an accident.

Salt Lake City Police Lt. Gary Young said the crash occurred Oct. 15 at 11:55 p.m. A Salt Lake cab driver saw the collision and followed the truck from 1080 W. North Temple, then noted its license plate and informed police.

Police arrested Molina, 22, at his home in Rose Park a short time later. The charges were filed in 3rd District Court.

Young said he didn't know if the victim's family had been notified and declined to release his name.
